Lexington serves as Neogen's Animal Safety headquarters, which recently announced an expansion, and has grown to 220 employees across two Lexington facilities and one in Mt. Sterling, KY. Utilizing many technologies from University of Kentucky based research, Neogen develops, manufactures, and markets a diverse line of products dedicated to food and animal safety.

Piramal Pharma Solutions is a Contract Development and Manufacturing Organization (CDMO) offering end-toend development and manufacturing solutions across the drug life cycle. They serve customers through a globally integrated network of facilities in North America, Europe, and Asia. Their Lexington facility is a USFDA and PMDA inspected, fully integrated site which offers analytical, formulation development, and manufacturing services with an emphasis on clinical trial to commercial-scale manufacturing of sterile liquid and lyophilized injectables. Primal Pharma Solutions acquired Lexington-based Coldstream Laboratories in 2015 and recently expanded into a new building on the University of Kentucky Coldstream Research Campus.

Founded in 2009, Summit Biosciences Inc. develops and manufactures prescription nasal sprays for pharmaceutical companies in the United States and Europe. The company operates its cGMP production facility on the University of Kentucky Coldstream Research Campus. A recent \$19 million expansion has added increased manufacturing, laboratory, and warehouse space to support clinical and commercial production of several new nasal medicines. With its unique platform and critical mass of expertise in Lexington, Summit Biosciences attracts nationwide talent to the Bluegrass.
